

Linda Stanier & Family Memorial Award - \$1200

Celebrating the life of Linda Stanier, an annual endowed award has been created to honour an Alberta professional craftsperson working in clay. Since the passing of Linda in May of 2004, her family has worked with the Edmonton Community Foundation and the Alberta Craft Council to establish this permanent endowed award with a value of (at least) \$1200.

A nominee should work and reside in Alberta, and be primarily a studio-based and full-time professional ceramist. A couple that works together on the same work may be considered as one nominee. Nominees may be in any career stage – emerging, mid, or mature – but must be career oriented.

Nominations may be made by individuals, groups such as guilds or by the Alberta Craft Council. Self nominations are also acceptable for the Stanier Award.

Annual Submission deadline **August 1**. The Awards Ceremony & Exhibition will take place during the fall in Calgary along with the annual ACC Alberta Craft Awards.
