Artwork is to be recent (within the last year) and must arrive with any special instructions on how to set it up. CCAA volunteers will place the artwork, and are not liable if a piece is damaged. If a piece arrives obviously damaged, CCAA will advise the artist on its removal and the artist will be offered an opportunity to replace it. The Artist will remove any packing materials when delivered, and supply the packing materials necessary upon pick-up, if the piece is not sold.

General Loan Conditions:

1. Care, preservation and exhibition: This agreement is between Calgary Clay Arts Association, and the Lender or Artist.
2. The Lender hereby agrees not to withdraw the loan article(s) during the time period of the show the work is exhibited in.
3. Insurance: The Artist is responsible for insuring the object from damage of any external cause during the period of the loan to the Calgary Clay Arts Association.
4. Reproduction rights: Unless the Artist/Lender on this document expressly refuses permission, the Calgary Clay Arts Association or its agents, may, photograph, film, videotape, and/or reproduce in any media the said art object for catalog, educational, or publicity purposes. The Calgary Clay Arts Association or its agents will credit Artist/Lender.
5. Commission Entitlement: Any sale during an exhibition of any of the said artworks or art objects permitted to be sold entitles Calgary Clay Arts Association to a 10% (ten per cent) commission, over and above the commission charged by the hosting gallery, irrespective to any outstanding commission agreements the artist/lender may have with a third party.
6. Shipping and Transportation and Return of Art Work: The Lender/Artist is responsible for shipping and handling the pieces to & from the gallery.
7. Notices: Any notices required and/or given pursuant to this agreement shall be made, respectively, to the Lender/Artist's address as stated above and to Calgary Clay Arts Association as set out at the top of this document.
8. Lender/Artist Covenants: The Lender/Artist (as the case may be) covenants and warrants that he/she has the right to lend the said object(s) for the purposes of this exhibition, and in respect of any contemplated sale of the said object, that he/she has the sole right, title and authority to sell, transfer and grant a sale of the artwork. Work must have been completed within the last year.
9. Covenants of Calgary Clay Arts Association: Calgary Clay Arts Association hereby covenants to exercise all due care, attention and diligence in respect of the loan and exhibition of the lent artwork. In addition, Calgary Clay Arts Association will make all reasonable efforts to keep the Lender/Artist advised of the status of the art object during the exhibition period and to account promptly according to the terms of the gallery/public space when there is any sale of the art object.
10. Governing Law. This agreement shall be governed in accordance with the laws of the Province of Alberta. In Witness of the Covenants made and information disclosed, the parties hereby agree to be bound by this agreement and the covenants and information disclosed within, and accordingly duly execute this agreement as of this effective date.
